COMPLIANCE COMMITMENT OF LEGRAND GROUP GENERAL MANAGEMENT

In accordance with its zero-tolerance policy, behaviour that does not comply with the Group's compliance commitments shall result in disciplinary action.

It is the responsibility of each of us, and in particular of managers, to ensure that employees are made aware and trained in the understanding of these major issues and how to apply good practice.

Each Legrand Group employee must be attentive with regard to compliance with these principles. I thank you all for your joint commitment to these subjects.
